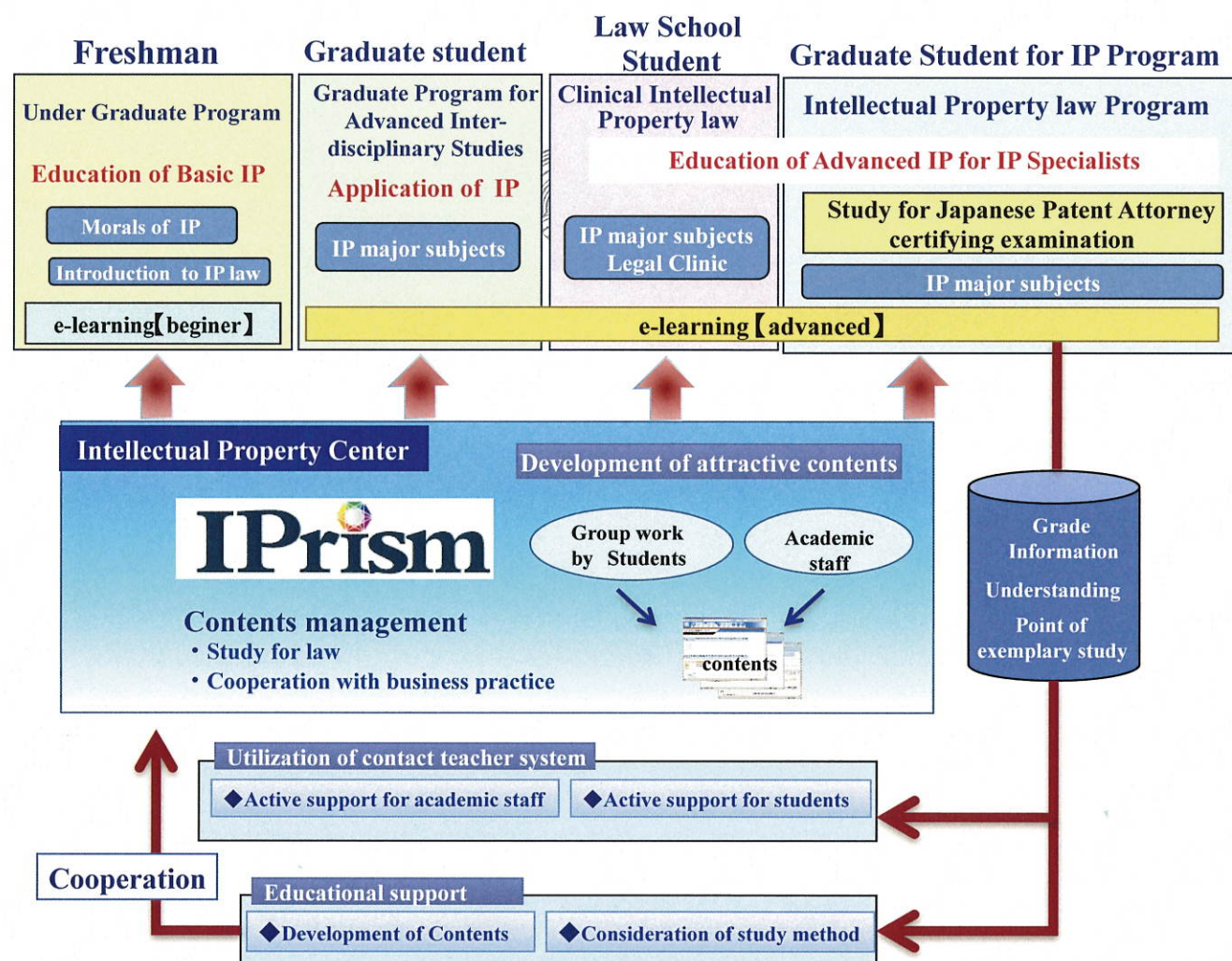


Our Mission

The Intellectual Property Center (IPrism), Osaka University was established on April 1, 2010 as a center for promoting comprehensive intellectual property education and research. Our faculty is composed of faculty members and scholars from university and IP practitioners with hands-on experience. IPrism aims to educate a new generation of specialists equipped with a broad intellectual property vision. In addition, members also aim to make social contributions in the intellectual property field. IPrism offers various educational opportunities for students such as a general education in Intellectual property for the undergraduate student. There is also an Intellectual property law program for graduate students. In particular, the Intellectual property law program will help develop leaders in practice or top specialists in intellectual property law. In addition to the lecture, students join an e-learning system using the internet. The learning and practical training provided will improve the student's intellectual property skills.

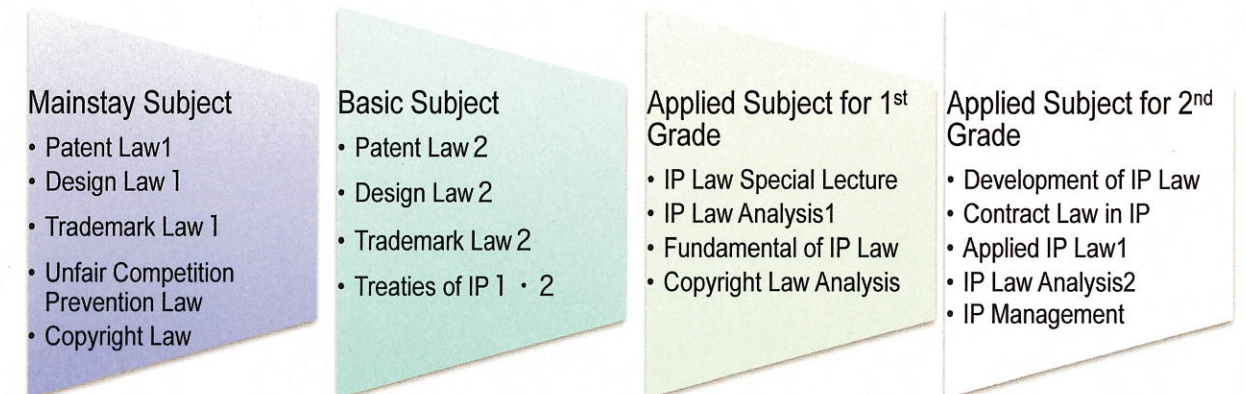
